




Mean sugar yield (tha-1) at mid-season and late-season harvests

Rainfall: 1400 mm - Altitude: 90 m


Mean of 2 ratoons

INTERNODES

- Purplish green when freshly trashed, greenish yellow
- when exposed to sunlight
- Medium to fairly long
- Medium to fairly large diameter
- Cvlindrical
- Medium waxiness
- Two rows of root primodia
- Slightly bulging, yellowish green growth ring
- Bud groove present close to bud
- Growth cracks common

LEAVES

- Leaf blade erect of medium length and width
- Leaf sheath slightly hairy
- Auricles:

Inner: ascending transitional Outer: deltoid very short

- Dewlaps: squarish deltoid
- Ligule: broad crescent



BUDS

- Narrow ovate with wings broadening towards apex
- Level with leaf scar and ending flush or inside growth ring
