



### Mean sugar yield (tha-1) at middle-season harvest


#### Mean of 3 ratoons

# **INTERNODES**

- Dark pink when freshly trashed, reddish brown when exposed to sunlight
- Fairly long
- Medium diameter
- Slightly curved strongly zigzagging
- Medium waxiness
- Narrow root band with two rows of root primodia
- Growth ring narrow and bulging
- Short and shallow bud groove present mostly on young
- Corky patches present on old internodes



# **LEAVES**

Leaf blade: long and erect, curved at tip

Leaf sheath: fairly hairy and waxy

Auricles:

Inner: deltoid Outer: dentoid

Dewlaps: squarish deltoid

Liqule: narrow crescent, symmetrical with lozenge





# **BUDS**

- Ovate with narrow wings on upper half
- Inserted above leaf scar, slightly overlapping growth ring
